- (6) Educational Facilities : 30 classrooms with 40 seats, 1 fully equipped language laboratories, 2 computer rooms, 6 science laboratories, 14 seminar rooms, a calligraphy room, a gymnasium, Judo & Kendo halls, a 25m swimming pool, tennis courts, etc.

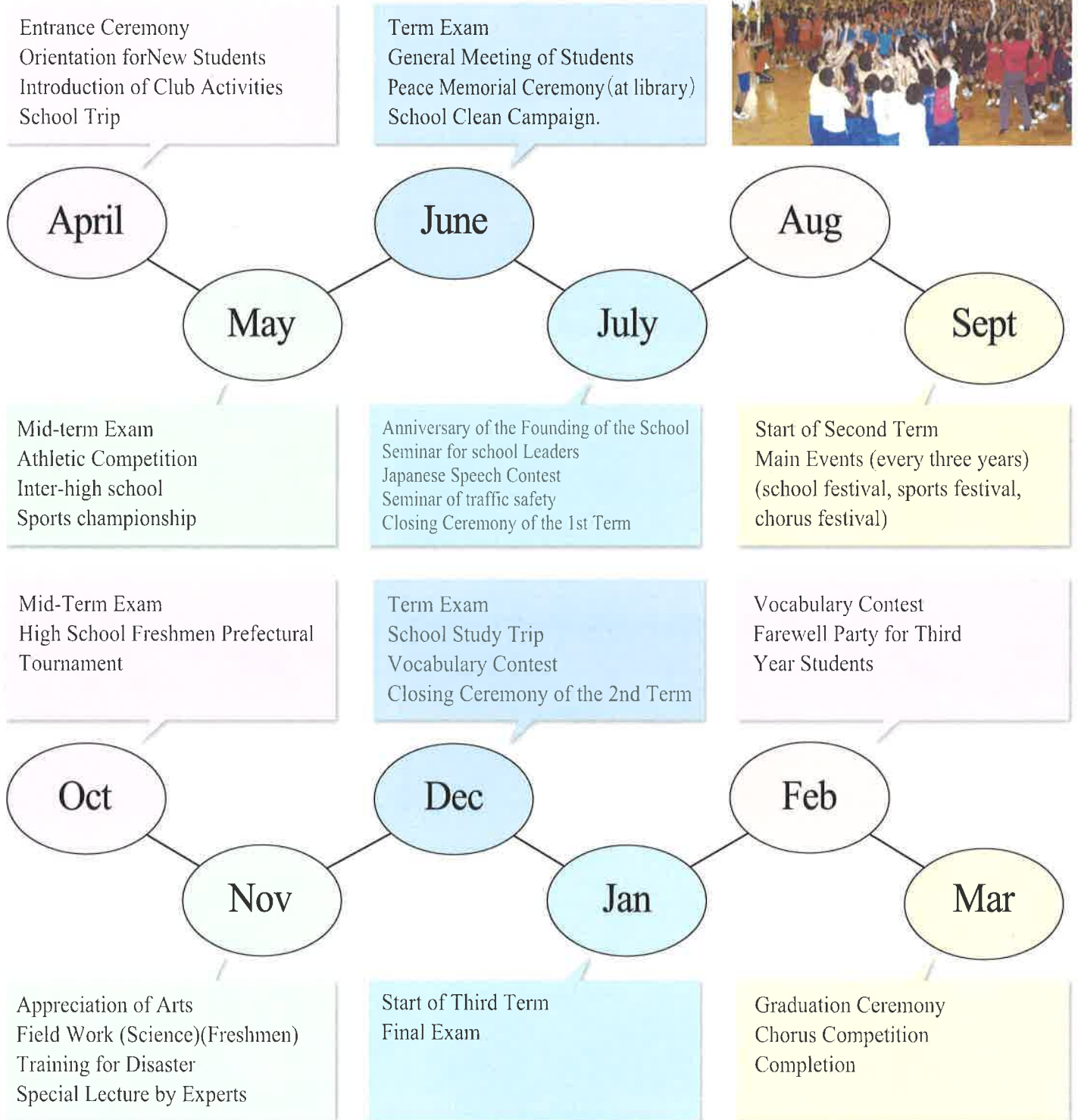
II Course Introduction
